First Screening: Conducted based upon application documents

Secondary Screening: 2 consecutive days between February 14, 2022 (Mon) and February 21, 2022 (Mon).

We do not conduct the test online.

The test schedule notification will be sent to those who passed the first screening on February 1st.

Day 1: Trial classes

Day 2: Parent-child interview, written test (Japanese, English, Mathematics) *

*For written tests, Japanese test will be conducted in Japanese, all others in English.

[Important Notes]

A. Application

- (1) Please write the applicant's name as shown on the resident certificate in the application form.
- (2) Please make sure that you have all the required and supporting documents before submitting an application. INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
- (3) If you do not receive the First Screening Result and Notice of Dates for Secondary Screening by February 7 (Mon), please contact the office for the delivery status.
- (4) If an applicant has failed the entrance exam, they may thereafter apply for the following school year exam (providing there are vacancies).
- (5) We may contact your child's current school.

B. Examination Dates

Please check the examination date and time on the letter that will be sent out on February 1 (Tue).

C. Examination Results

(1) All applicants will be notified of the results by mail on February 28 (Fri). Subject to change

(2) We will NOT answer any inquiries regarding the result, acceptance rate, etc.

D. Enrollment Procedures

- (1) Successful applicants who wish to be enrolled in Okinawa AMICUS International must submit the required documents and pay the entrance fee of 220,000 yen. The details will be notified along with the acceptance letter.
- (2) Failing to submit the required documents or pay the entrance fees by the deadline may result in withdrawal. In that case, submission of "Enrollment Withdrawal Form" is required.
- (3) If you wish to withdraw from enrollment after receiving the acceptance letter, please contact the administration office and submit the "Enrollment Withdrawal Form".

E. Others

- (1) Application fees and submitted documents will not be returned under any circumstances.
- (2) No supplementary English lessons will be provided for transfer students.
- (3) School insurance will not cover injuries occurring during examination period.
- (4) At Elementary level JSL (Japanese as the Second Language) is available for those who meet our requirements.
- (5) Permission for proceeding to AMICUS Junior High from AMICUS Elementary will be granted following a Principal's recommendation based on documents prepared by AMICUS Elementary.

F. Tuition and Fees after the Enrollment

(1) "Monthly Tuition" needs to be paid from the month the student starts attending AMICUS.

- (2) "Facility Expense" and "Welfare Fee" will be calculated per month in the semester that a student starts.
- (3) "Material and Activity Fee" needs to be paid for the semester when the student starts attending AMICUS.

For examinees and parents [Important] Countermeasures against COVID-19 infection on the day of the secondary examination

- ① Please refrain from traveling abroad for 2 weeks before the test date. If you live overseas, please come to Japan at least 2 weeks in advance.
